1. Sally Ride was the first woman from the U.S. to fly into space aboard STS-7 on June 18, 1983. Born 1951.
2. Sandra Day O'Connor was the first woman to be named a U.S. Supreme Court Justice, in 1981. Born 1930.
3. Elizabeth Blackwell was the first woman to graduate from medical school in the U.S., in 1849. Born 1821, died 1910
4. Amelia Earhart was the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean, on May 20 and 21, 1932. Born 1897, disappeared while flying 1937.
5. Answer C. In 1920 women secured the right to vote in the U.S with the passage of the 19th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.
